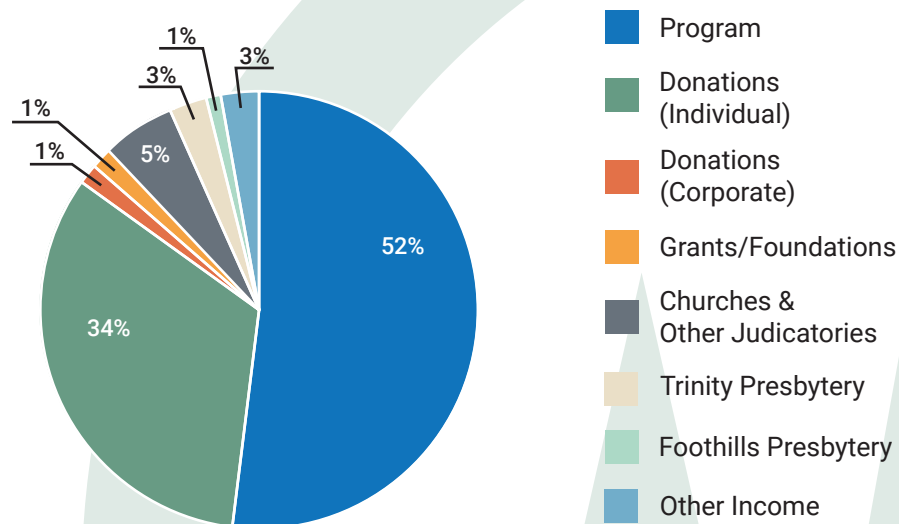

FROM THE DIRECTORS

Our 2020-2021 program year was welcomed with encouragement, excitement, and a breath of fresh air that we so often craved in 2020. The transition into a covid-aware world continues to require pivots, radical creativity, and continual recommitment to our core mission. Through months of recovery, we have never stopped **moving forward in faith and fellowship**. We are so very thankful for each of our donors and supporting organizations that have seen us through a very tough economic cycle. We are also very grateful to camper families, guests, and program participants that have moved forward with us as we've adapted and made necessary adjustments to continue providing top-quality programs in a safe environment.

Moving forward has looked unique again in this year. Our emergency sheltering of the Imani Milele Choir ended in November of 2020 after 251 days. The choir's impact on our staff and our ministry will last forever, with many hopes for developing a long term partnership that would bring future choirs to our site for a time of rest and relaxation during their journeys.

When the timing was right, our focus shifted to reopening for guest groups and planning for summer of 2021 and beyond. We were eager to jump right back in to summer programs! In order to meet public health recommendations and keep all campers and staff safe, we chose to operate at 50% capacity. It did our souls good to be back at camp! Unfortunately, due to subsequent waves of the pandemic, our programming and guest groups in the spring and fall seasons were severely curtailed. Despite these limitations, we successfully returned to hosting groups and modified on-site programming, with no reported cases of Covid-19. We have an optimistic outlook on fully recovering and moving forward with our mission in the year ahead.

Like the whole world, we look forward to a time when reporting on our activities will not include tones of pandemic challenges. We are optimistic that the year ahead will bring increased opportunities for gathering together around this important ministry of Camp Fellowship that first began over 73 years ago! We are eager to continue the nurturing of key strategic partnerships and the development of programs and activities that will shape the lives of children, youth and adults as we move forward together in Faith and Fellowship!

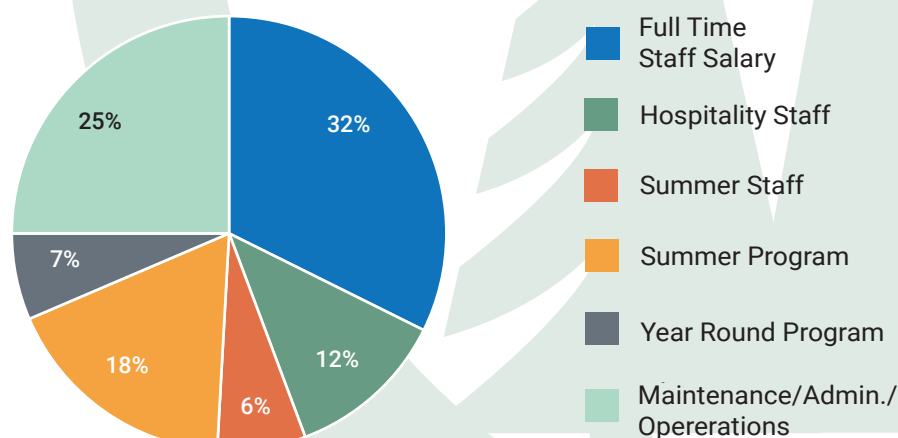
